Mini Piqué

Weight	165-200 g/m ² (4.9-5.9 oz/yd ²)
Composition	100% polyester (typical); fine/microfilament yarn common in golf/sublimation.
Knit type	Fine-gauge piqué · Piqué
Use class	Everyday
Stretch	Mechanical stretch
Knit	Same knit+tuck logic as standard piqué, with a tighter tuck repeat and finer yarn/gauge for smaller, denser cells.
Hand	Finer, flatter and silkier than standard piqué; a more refined texture, a lighter, cooler hand.
Typical use	Light/premium polos · golf-tennis tops · summer sport
Strength	A more refined, lighter piqué with a fine cell texture — ideal for summer polos.
Watch for	Lighter, so it sits less structured/opaque; can be semi-sheer at very low weights.

Typical technical ranges

Weight tolerance	±5% (typical); ±5-7% for relief/jacquard or elastane builds
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Width	Open width ~150-190 cm; tubular ~70-95 cm — depends on machine diameter/gauge and stenter/draw setting, set at finishing
Shrinkage (wash)	100% PES wash shrinkage length/width ~-1% to -4% (near the low end with good heat-set); elastane piqué -3% to -6%
Color fastness	Wash 4-5; rubbing dry 4-5, wet/dark-brilliant shades 3-4; light 4-6 (medium/dark shades often 5+) · ISO grey scale
Abrasion / pilling	Martindale ~15,000-30,000+ cycles (abrasion, depends on end use/finish); pilling typically 3-4, up to 4 with anti-pill finish · ISO 12947 / ISO 12945
Gauge / yarn	Standard piqué ~E18-E28 (classic polo mostly E20-E24); mini/fine piqué ~E28-E32; yarn ~75-150 denier textured filament
